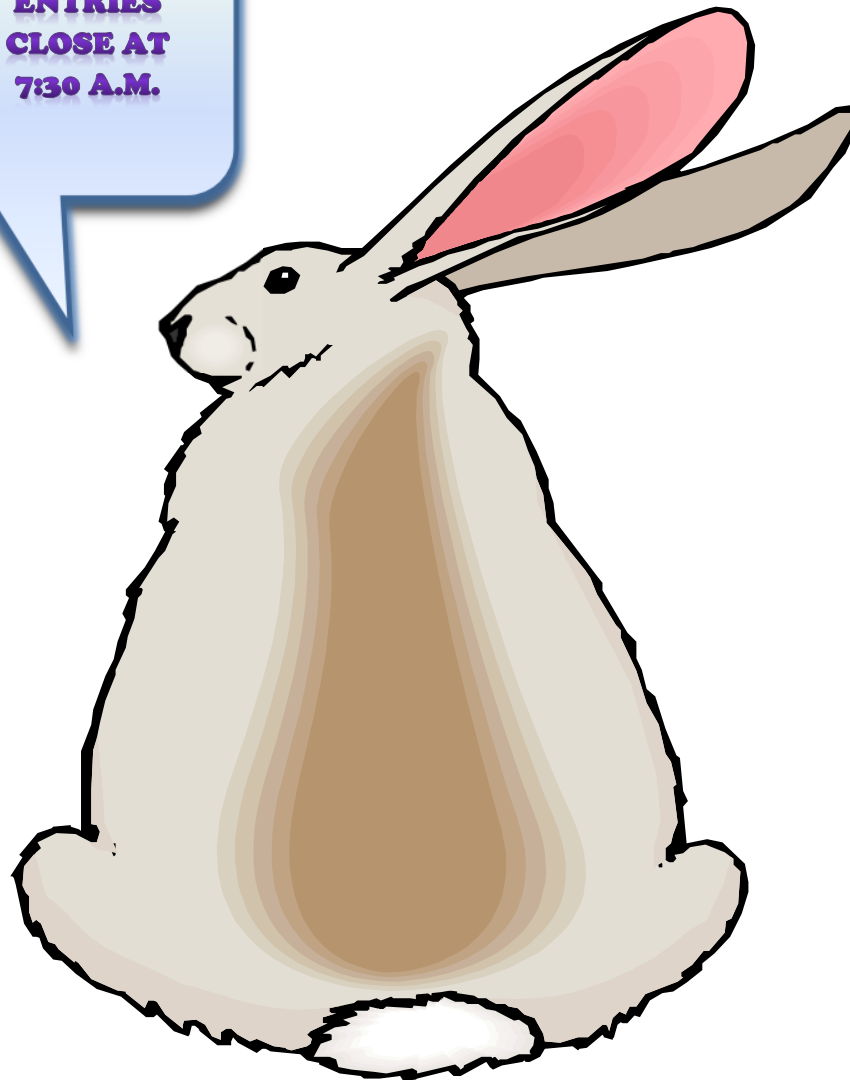

Take Interstate I-90 (NYS Thruway) to Exit 48: Batavia, NY. Go South on Rte 98 (South is a left turn after leaving the toll booths through the town of Batavia. (5.4 miles to Dodgeson Rd.) Turn Right on to Dodgeson Road. Go 3.5 miles . The Beagle

Club will be on your right ¼ mile after you pass Seward Road (which is on your left.)
